THE RUN FOR LITHIUM

Lithium is a key component in lithium-ion batteries, which are used in a wide range of devices, including electric vehicles, laptops, and smartphones. As the demand for these devices continues to grow, so too does the demand for lithium. Lithium is expected to be one of the most important metals in the world, and its price is likely to continue to rise.

In 2023, the Geological Survey of India (GSI) detected lithium reserves in Jammu & Kashmir. The GSI estimated that the Salal-Haimana area of Reasi district in Jammu and Kashmir has 5.9 million tonnes of lithium resources. This is the largest lithium reserve ever discovered in India.

The discovery of these lithium reserves is significant for India, as it will help to reduce the country's dependence on imports of lithium. India is currently the world's fifth largest importer of lithium, and the discovery of these reserves could help to make India self-sufficient in lithium production. India spent \$1,791.35 million to import 5,486.18 lakh units of lithium-ion batteries during April-November 2022 period as against import of 6,167.68 lakh units of lithium-ion batteries for \$1,832.44 million in 2021-22.

The discovery of lithium reserves in India is also significant for the global lithium market. India is a large and growing market for electric vehicles, and the availability of lithium in India could help to drive the growth of the electric vehicle market in India.


KWIBUKA (REMEMBRANCE) DAY WITH RWANDA HIGH COMMISSION

INDIA AFRICA CONNECTION

SUB SAHARAN AFRICA TO LEAD GROWTH

The Sub-Saharan African Region (East, West, Central and Southern Region) comprising 48 countries.

Bilateral trade between India and Sub Saharan Africa (SSA) region was USD 74.86 billion in 2021-22 registering a growth of 59.91% compared to 2020-21. India's exports to SSA region were at USD 33.08 billion and recorded a growth of 44.31% in 2021-22 vis a vis 2020-21. India's imports from SSA region were USD 41.77 billion and registered a growth of 74.87% during the same period. A trade deficit of USD 8.69 billion was registered in 2021-22. (Statistics from the Ministry of Commerce, Govt of India).
